Directions to Soorp Asdvadzadzin Armenian Apostolic Church

From Boston: Mass Pike to 495 south (exit 11A), then take exit 21B (W. Main Street, Upton). Right off exit, go through set of lights and go 2 miles (pond on left). Bear right at small fork (High St.). Go 1 mile to set of lights and straight across, .6 miles to end. Turn right and go 2.4 miles. Take right onto Church St. and go approx. 1 mile. The church is on the right. Parking is available on the street.

From Providence: Take route 146 North to Exit #5, Main Street (Northbridge/Whitinsville) exit. Veer right off the exit and continue about 1 1/2 miles to lights at town hall and bank building. Go straight through this set of lights. Bear left at next light onto Church Street through downtown Whitinsville. Armenian Church is roughly 3/4 of a mile on the left. Parking is available on the street.
